IN THE FIRST PLACE

Called by the Spirit, we serve Christ, sharing God's love with all.

50 YEARS

WOW! Where has time gone? It is hard to believe that on June 8, 2019 I will celebrate 50 years as Organist at First Lutheran Church!!!

I can remember the day that my Washburn University organ professor, Max Elsberry, told me that First Lutheran Church was looking for an organist, and I should apply for the job. Would they hire a twenty-year-old college student with a little experience? Geneva Schad, Mary Nice, and Pastor Tonsing interviewed me and a couple of days later, I received a call that I got the job. What was I getting into? At the same time, the Church was looking for a Choir Director and hired Dr. John Buckner. Over the years, I have worked with many Pastors - Dr. Ernest Tonsing, Richard Carlson, Dr. Dale Gregoriew, Duane Heckman (interim), Gerald Weeks, Don Conrad (interim), Elwyn Luber, Lesley Radius (interim), and Jenny Jackson! Choir Directors I have worked with are Dr. John Buckner, Martha Carpenter, David Collins, Brooks Reynolds (interim), and Mark Fuller.

Fifty years ago, the organ had four (4) ranks of pipes (but it was a pipe organ). In other words, a very small organ for the size of the Church. Over the years, a new exposed Great Division was added, and thanks to Betty Sisk, a beautiful new state-of-the-art three manual console and three additional ranks were added in memory of Dr. Phil Sisk. When the original First Lutheran Church at 5th and Harrison was about to be demolished, I removed the pipe organ that was installed in the 1930's. After three years of rebuilding, re-wiring, and cleaning the organ, the pipes from that organ have been installed as part of our current organ, an important part of our history from the 5th and Harrison church. Other ranks of pipes have been obtained over the years and incorporated into our current organ. As of today, the organ has 31 ranks of pipes with an approximate value of a little under \$1,000,000.00 to replace it.

When the chapel was built, I obtained a four rank pipe organ from Mrs. Helen Baugh, which has a replacement value around \$100,000.00. She donated the organ to our church!

Special "Thanks" to my wife, Linda, my children, and grandchildren, and friends who have helped carry pipes, and supported my music passion over the years. It has truly been a JOY and a privilege to serve as the organist here all these years! I still look forward to each service!

On June 9th at 4:00 p.m., I will be giving a 50th Anniversary Recital (free), here at First Lutheran. This will feature pieces that I learned from each of my four organ teachers, hymn preludes based on Lutheran/Swedish hymns, and one concert piece. I hope you will be able to attend! A reception will follow.
